49) Highway Superintendent Jay Rust reported that the Highway Department has been working on cutting brush on the Mt Arab road. They have been able to lay cob rock in some areas, but considering the weight of the dump trucks they will have to wait for the roads to dry out before they can do more work. DATED: March 14, 2024

This contract made the <u>14th</u> day of <u>March</u> 2024 by and between the Town of <u>Piercefield</u> hereinafter called the "Town" and St. Lawrence County Highway Department, hereinafter called the "County".

ARTICLE 1 - SCOPE OF WORK

The Town shall furnish all of the equipment and perform all of the work described in the Project Specifications attached.

ARTICLE 2 - TIME OF COMPLETION

The work to be performed under this contract shall be commenced within ten days after receipt of "Notice to Proceed" and shall be completed by September 15,2024.

ARTICLE 3 - THE CONTRACT SUM

The County shall pay the Town for performance of the Contract in current funds at the rate of $\frac{$320.00}{$}$ per mile for $\frac{2.35}{$}$ miles equaling Seven hundred fifty two (\$752.00) upon completion of the work and submission of a properly certified invoice.

Upon receipt of notice that the work is ready for final inspection and acceptance, the County will promptly make such inspection, and when it finds the work acceptable under the contract and the contract fully performed, it shall promptly approve payment for the entire amount due the Town.

The making and acceptance of the final payment shall constitute a waiver of all claims by the County, except those arising from unsettled liens, from faulty work appearing after payment or from requirements of the specifications, and of all claims by the Town except those previously made and still unsettled.
