Annual Review and Public Hearing for Agricultural Districts 1 and 2

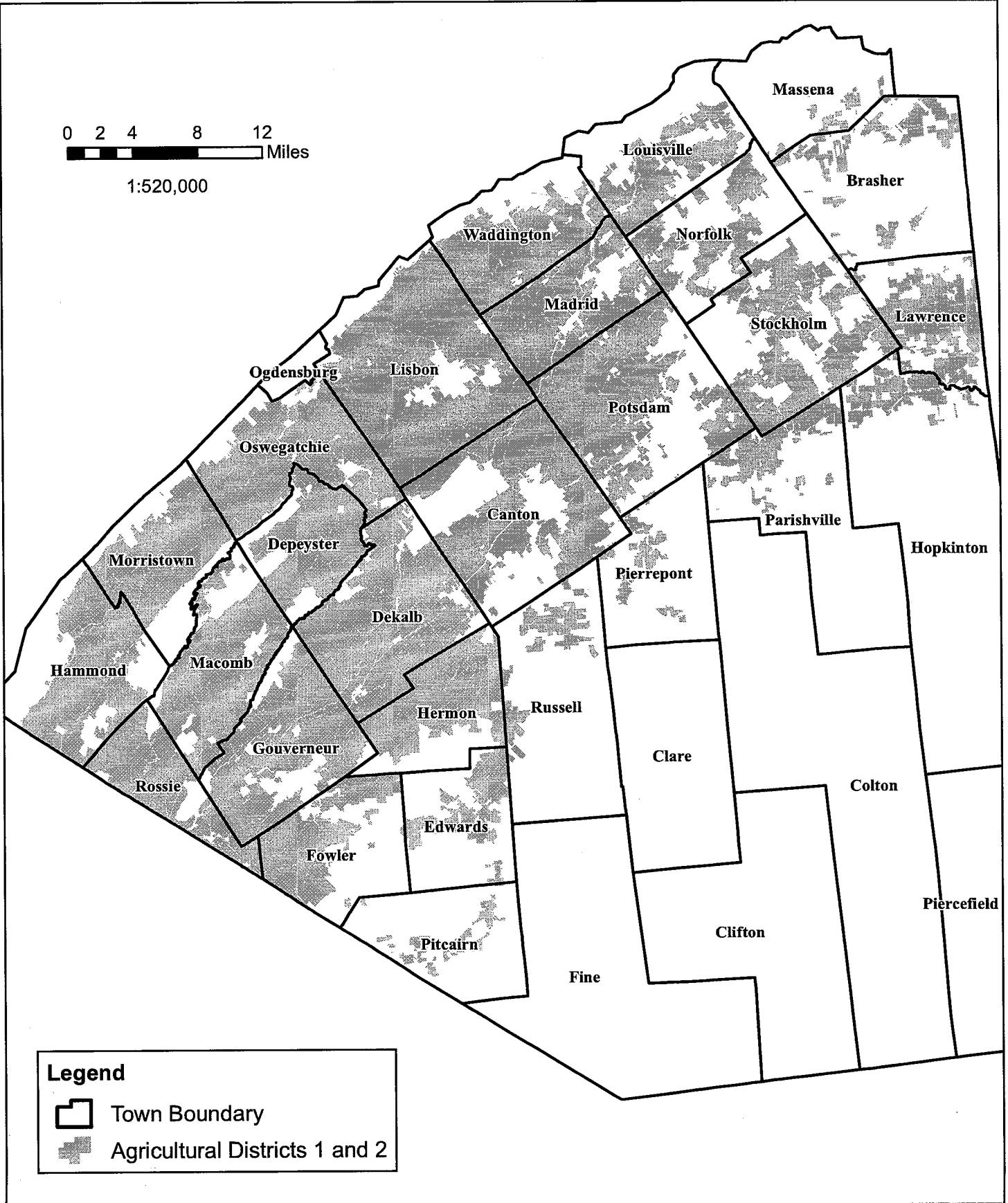
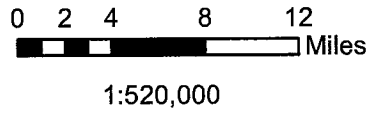
During the month of March, St. Lawrence County conducts its annual review for Agricultural Districts 1 and 2. The Agricultural Districts program helps protect sound farming activities from nuisance lawsuits and unreasonable land use regulations. Ag District 1 primarily consists of agricultural lands in the western and southern portions of the county, and Ag District 2 spans across the county's northern and eastern regions. From March 1st to the 30th, the County will accept applications from property owners to add land to an ag district. Applications may be obtained by calling (315) 379-2292, emailing mlarson@stlawco.org, or by downloading a form at www.stlawco.org/Departments/Planning/AgDistrictMap. All forms must be received or postmarked no later than March 30th.



Requests submitted to the County will be reviewed by the Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board at their April 2nd meeting, and will make a recommendation to the Board of Legislators on the requested additions. A public hearing will be held on Tuesday, April 21, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. to give the public the opportunity to comment on the Agriculture and Farmland Protection Board's recommendation on the requested additions. The hearing will be held in the County Planning Office, located on the 2nd floor of the Public Safety Complex at 49 ½ Court Street in Canton.

At the public hearing, Planning staff will present an overview of the Ag District program; summarize the requested additions; discuss the Agriculture and Farmland Protection Board's recommendation on the proposed changes; and accept public comments on the recommendation.
